78 hours of Mark Hogen's time is requested as set out below, or as directed by the board of supervisors:

36 HOURS: Bonner SWCD requests Mark Hogen's attendance at 8 of their 12 district meetings in FY2014, which would be approximately 2 per quarter. At 2.5 hours per meeting plus 2 hours travel, this request is for 36 hours of his time.

Mark's input at our board meetings is crucial to our understanding of all SWC actions, requests, and information. His input helps the board in completing reports, helps keep us abreast of vital legislative issues regarding districts and conservation, helps give a more historic background to issues, and helps give more current information regarding grant writing, new projects, and implementation of projects.

10 HOURS: Bonner SWCD requests Mark Hogen's assistance at the Idaho State Forestry Contest on the 2nd Thursday of May, as well as his input before and after the contest regarding the Soils/Water Quality station where he assists. The day of the Contest this would take 7 hours, with 1.5 hours prep time, and 1.5 hours for evaluation.

The Idaho State Forestry Contest brings 450 to 500 students from the northern part of Idaho, usually from Grangeville and north. Contestants come from schools, Boy Scout Troops, and 4-Groups for this one-day contest which covers 10 forestry-related stations that the students study the Idaho State Forestry Contest Manual to prepare for. The event takes place at the Delay Farm in Careywood, and in FY2015 it will be the 33rd anniversary. Awards are given to top teams and individuals in three different categories: Senior High School, Junior High School, and Rookies, which includes 5th and 6th graders wishing to compete. Elementary students may also attend for instruction only.

32 HOURS: Bonner SWCD requests Mark Hogen's assistance at the two Water Festivals for 5th graders to be held in Kootenai County and Shoshone County in May of 2015. These outdoor educational experiences for 5th graders would benefit from Mark's help in setting up - 1 day for each event, and for helping to teach on water quality issues - 1 day for each event. These Water Festivals will be funded through an EPA grant administered by Bonner SWCD. Bonner SWCD has helped sponsor the Pend Oreille Water Festival for 19 years in Bonner County, and has written the EPA grant to expand to conducting 4 more water festivals at the request of people in 4 separate counties – Kootenai, Shoshone, Boundary, and Ponderay WA.



ENGINEERING ASSISTANCE BY BILL LILLIBRIDGE: 80 HOURS/YR
Date: March 31, 2014

The Bonner SWCD is requesting comprehensive technical assistance from ISWCC regarding engineering guidance in Bonner County. The board has listed Bill Lillibridge as a responsible party for the engineering design and follow through on a stormwater project in Ponderay.

The Ponderay location will address stormwater and related seasonal flooding utilizing a natural area adjacent to commercial development. Currently, spring runoff flows between the natural area and the edge of a parking lot, where it has cut a channel that continues to erode. Underground utilities are threatened by the erosion and ponding water. The channel will be stabilized and storage and treatment capacity will be enhanced. This will relieve flooding issues upslope on other properties and will dissipate erosive forces that continue downstream. This project will be used to lessen the effects of spring runoff, provide treatment of stormwater via vegetated features, reduce the urge by citizens to dig their own flooding solutions without proper planning, and provide a pleasant gathering place for pedestrians.

Partners for this project include the City of Sandpoint, the City of Ponderay, Sandpoint Urban Renewal Agency, the Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS), Idaho Soil and Water Conservation Commission (ISWCC), the Panhandle Stormwater and Erosion Education Program (SEEP), and possibly the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (a grant proposal has been submitted to them for a portion of the project).

ISWCC assistance will be utilized for the engineering for this project.


